#### Remembrance week

This week the children will be taking part in various activities to remember those lost in the wars and commemorate 100 years since WW1 ended. Before half term the children made poppies that are displayed alongside poppies made by St George's and Micklehurst Primary Schools that are now on display at St George's Church. On Thursday 8 November Year 2 - 6 will be visiting St George's Church to see the 'There, but not there' – Mossley Remembers exhibition.



#### PTA Autumn Disco Thursday 8 November

Don't forget to buy tickets for the disco which is taking place this Thursday. Children attending the 3.30pm – 4.30pm (Y1,2 and Y3) disco can bring a change of clothes with them to school on the day and staff will get the children changed before the disco starts. Parents of children attending this disco do not need to do anything between 3.15 – 3.30pm as staff will supervise the children during this time. Children that are attending the 4.30pm disco will need picking up at 3.15pm and be returned at 4.30pm, which will give them time to get change if they wanted to.
