If you can spare any of the above items they would be much appreciated. In addition to the sales stalls, we will have games, refreshments and of course, 'You Know Who' will be there!


If you would like to volunteer to help during the day or night, please come to the office and let us know. We would really appreciate your help.

In Nursery they have a Post Office role play area and would be grateful of any items such as, new and used envelopes, stamps, greetings cards, small boxes and wrapping paper.


Roadworks on Stockport Road
