Christmas Jumper Day – Friday 13 December

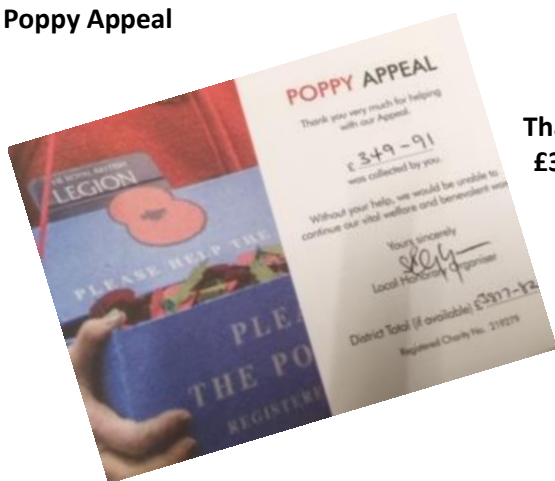
