## Milton St John's Foodbank



## **Updated Christmas activities**



We have also booked a virtual pantomime for the children to watch at some point during the week too.

# PTA Christmas fundraising and spreading cheer!

The PTA are selling lovely star Christmas decorations that the children can decorate at home for £1.50. These would make lovely gifts. They are also selling a lantern template, again for the children to decorate at home, that we then hope will be put in people's windows to spread a light of hope this Christmas. It would be lovely for the children to spot Milton's Lanterns of Hope in lots of windows over the festive period. A Lantern template is 50p. Unfortunately, as these items will be ordered in an ad hoc way we are unable to add this to our online money system, therefore money will have to be sent in an envelope clearly stating what items you would like and your child's name/ year group please.





For information - The wooden stars come in two flat pieces so they are easy to decorate with paints, pens, sequins, glitter, ribbon, wrapping paper – it's all up to you!

Once you have decorated your stars you will need to carefully slide the pieces together, and they may need a touch of glue.

Add the golden string and they are ready to hang on the tree!

The PTA are also selling lantern templates for 50p. For 50p the children will get two templates which they can colour and decorate. We are hoping that families display the 2d 'lantern of hope' picture in their windows for all to see and hang their 3d lantern somewhere in your homes.

#### Lockdown

Please note the following reminders:

Please remember that only one adult is allowed to collect and drop off children.

If a member of the household has symptoms and has to have a test, **the whole household must isolate until the results come back.** 

Should your child test positive, it is imperative that we are informed straight away, either by phone (during school hours) or via the <a href="mailto:positivecovid@milton-st-johns.tameside.sch.uk">positivecovid@milton-st-johns.tameside.sch.uk</a> email address (out of school hours; after 3.30pm or during the weekends). Please do not presume that we will have been informed by track and trace. Please include the following information in the email or conversation:

Name of child
Class
Date symptoms started
Date child was last in school
Date that a test was taken
Also include if your child attended Skools Out and the date they attended

We have to have the above information to be able to liaise with Public Health England and ascertain what we have to do in each circumstance. We have to follow their advice at all times and the information above is critical in working out isolation dates if classes have to isolate. We have been informed that we have to track back 48 hours prior to the onset of symptoms and determine who may have been in contact during those hours.

## **Colder weather**

The weather is clearly getting colder. This will certainly become even more challenging as the weather deteriorates. Current guidelines state that the windows in frequently used rooms <u>must</u> be open to allow adequate ventilation throughout the room. Therefore, please ensure your child has warm, protective clothing for outside and please consider dressing the children in thermal undergarments. Additional to this, the children are also allowed to wear gilets/body warmer type clothing in class should they need to (please do not worry about the colour matching the uniform colours in this case).
