LIVING WITH COVID

As you will be aware, new guidance around Covid was put in place from 1 April. The key change that affects school is that if anyone has a positive Covid -19 test, they should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days for adults, or 3 days for those under 18 (we anticipate that fewer people will be testing but families and staff may still have LFTs left over at home which they may still use, and these are still available to purchase from high street pharmacies).
