The children from Y1 – 6 have taken part in an Anti-Bullying assembly for Anti bullying week. The theme this year is 'Reach Out' and in assembly we talked about who the children felt they could reach out to and what they could do if they or someone they know was being bullied. The Anti-Bullying Alliance has a very useful website and states...

Bullying affects millions of lives and can leave us feeling hopeless. But it doesn't have to be this way. If we challenge it, we can change it. And it starts by reaching out.

To raise much needed funds for the school, we would like the children to bring £5 into school by Thursday 1 December (this won't be on online, children need to bring £5 into school to their teacher please). This money will

then be exchanged for tokens to use at their Christmas Fair day. Activities will include games/chocolate tombola etc. If this causes some financial concerns, please speak to the office.



We have already received a kind donation from Skools Out of £1000 for this project, but need to raise more in order for it to be successful. Some of the money raised will also subsidise the KS2 pantomime and pay for EYFS and KS1 parties.

So that each class can have their own chocolate tombola, we would like the children to bring a chocolate donation in on Thursday 1 December. In return the children are able to come to school with crazy hair on this day.

#### **CLOSING DATES FOR RECEPTION APPLICATIONS**

Tameside residents should use the Tameside Citizen Portal to apply for a Reception place. If you do not live within Tameside but wish to apply for a place at a Tameside school, you should apply via your own Local Authority. (For example, if you are an Oldham resident you will need to apply via Oldham MBC admissions, for any Tameside School)

The closing date for submitting a Reception 2023 school application is 15 January 2023. (Applications submitted after this date will be processed as a 'late' application)
