MAIN SCHOOL GATES

Now that both gates are open, a number of parents have asked why they can't walk through the playground to get to the other side of the school e.g. from the main gate on Mill Lane across towards the kitchen gate, or from the kitchen gate to the main entrance before or after school.

We understand that this may be an inconvenience, but it is for safety reasons that we politely ask that parents respect the system we have in place. Once the bell goes at 8.45am the school doors are open for the children to enter and we find that standing on the gate enables us to ensure that the children go into school safely. If a number of parents walk across the playground we are unable to see if an adult has entered or exited the main school building where the children enter. For safeguarding reasons, it is not appropriate for parents/adults to be unsupervised in the school building. Equally, at home time, as classes are staggered it is safer for the children to be released safely from the gates without parents trying to get into and across the playground. Gates will be closed after a class has been released at home time. Anyone picking their child up late will need to come to the new main entrance.

PTA FILM NIGHT

The PTA recently met and have some amazing ideas for the year ahead. They are currently busy organising a film night for the children to attend before Christmas, which is fantastic! More details about the dates/times will soon follow.

CHRISTMAS FAIR AND CRAFT DAYS

Following on from the success last year with our Christmas Fair and Craft Days, the children will be taking part in a Christmas Fair and Craft day during the week beginning 12 December. We understand that some parents may prefer the traditional evening Christmas Fairs that we have done in the past and may be disappointed with this decision, but doing this in school time allows <u>all</u> children to participate and hopefully keeps costs down for parents.

The day will be a special, fun and exciting time where the children will have their own Christmas Fair experience as well as take part in Christmas craft activities.

To raise much needed funds for the school, we would like the children to bring £5 into school by **Thursday 1 December** (this won't be on online, children need to bring £5 into school to their teacher please). This money will



then be exchanged for tokens to use at their Christmas Fair day. Activities will include games/chocolate tombola etc. If this causes some financial concerns, please speak to the office.

Money raised at the Fair will be used towards funding a new Forest School cabin that we have been planning for some time. We have already received a kind donation from Skools Out of £1000 for this project, but need to raise more in order for it to be successful. Some of the money raised will also subsidise the KS2 pantomime and pay for EYFS and KS1 parties.

So that each class can have their own chocolate tombola, we would like the children to bring a chocolate donation in on Wednesday 30 November. In return the children are able to come to school with crazy hair on this day.


