
What Parents & carers Need to Know about YouTube Kids is a child-friendly version of YouTube which offers a colourful and easy-to-navigate environment that's suitable for young children. This app is easily accessible and available for mobile devices, which can be downloaded without needing the YouTube app on the device. Despite YouTube Kids seeming like a very child-friendly platform, it has raised concerns over its advertising and SETTING inappropriate content seeping through the curation process. UP Download the YouTube Kids app and connect your own YouTube channel. 2 Input your child's name, age and birth month. OSCAR 3 Select the types of videos you want to include for your child based on their age and your own personal choice. If you decide to approve the content yourself, the app will present you with sample videos for you to accept and reject. 0 5 Once you've made your a choice, you're ready to use the app! Advice for Parents & Carers < BE WARY OF UNSUITABLE CONTENT REMOVE ADVERTISEMENTS DISABLE SEARCH OPTION YouTube Kids has a far lower chance of showing unsuitable material than YouTube, but there are still reports of malicious users deliberately uploading inappropriate content. It's important that your child feels able to talk to you if they were ever exposed to upsetting content in the future. It's also safest to report inappropriate videos: tap the three dots in the corner of the video and select 'Report'. YouTube Kids allows you to disable the sear feature, which you may find useful in preve your child from unintentionally finding age-inappropriate content. Doing this will o give you more control over what your child watching. It's also worth noting that setting age limit will ensure that your child is only exposed to recommended videos that are deemed suitable for their age group. Like YouTube, adverts on YouTube Kids are also quite pervasive. If you decide you don't want your child being exposed to adverts, you can subscribe to YouTube Premium which will remove adverts on YouTube Kids. However, it's worth remembering that this doesn't block adverts that content creators decide to make as part of their content, and children are still able to access channels from branded fast food or toy companies. (18) RESTRICT VIEWING TIME MONITOR WATCH HISTORY WATCH TOGETHER The YouTube Kids app provides you with the option of setting up a timer to monitor and limit your child's daily usage, which automatically stops the video when it reaches the set time. It may be best to make use of this feature to prevent screen addiction - which can potentially lead to children staying up too late, affecting their mood and concentration the following day. YouTube Kids has also made it possible for parents and carers to see what their children are watching on the app by clicking on the Recommended' icon on the top right of the home screen. It may also be worth having a look at what your child has recently watched by clicking on their history tab. The red bar or the video shows how much of the video has been watched It's important to make YouTube Kids a fun and positive experience for your child. This may requir spending time finding channels and content that you and your child will enjoy and benefit from. Try introducing family sessions where you can share the most enjoyable videos that you and your child have recently watched. Dear parents,

Places are now available to join a new 12-week football course every Friday at Great Academy Ashton, starting 12th May, which is open to both boys and girls.

Our courses teach children correct football techniques by FA qualified coaches who have full DBS (CRB) clearance to work with children. The structure for the course is 'FUN through Football,' building confidence for total beginners and moving onto more complex sessions for experienced players.

We provide a **ball per player** for the majority of our drills ensuring children get more touches of the ball and improve quicker than conventional coaching where children are waiting around to have a turn. The sessions are held on the grass pitch so please wear suitable footwear. Players are also advised to bring a still drink for the session.

The club has links to local junior teams of which players will be able to play for at the weekend. Players who show advanced ability on the course will be recommended for trials at professional academies. Players who have previously attended courses are currently playing for Blackburn Rovers, Preston North End, Manchester United, Liverpool, Blackpool, Everton, Burnley, Bolton, Oldham, Rochdale and Wigan.

The cost of the course is just over £5 per week, which is payable in two instalments. The first payment of £25 is due when booking your child on and the second payment of £45 due at the first session. Parents are encouraged to watch the sessions but are welcome to leave children, as every session is fully supervised.

****NEW TOURNAMENT FORMAT****

Every four weeks we have a tournament in order for the children to put their new-found skills into practice with medals and trophies awarded at the end of the course for various categories.
