The PTA are trying really hard to raise funds to help us improve our playground and have come up with a fabulous 'Make the Rules Day' event on the last day of this half term.

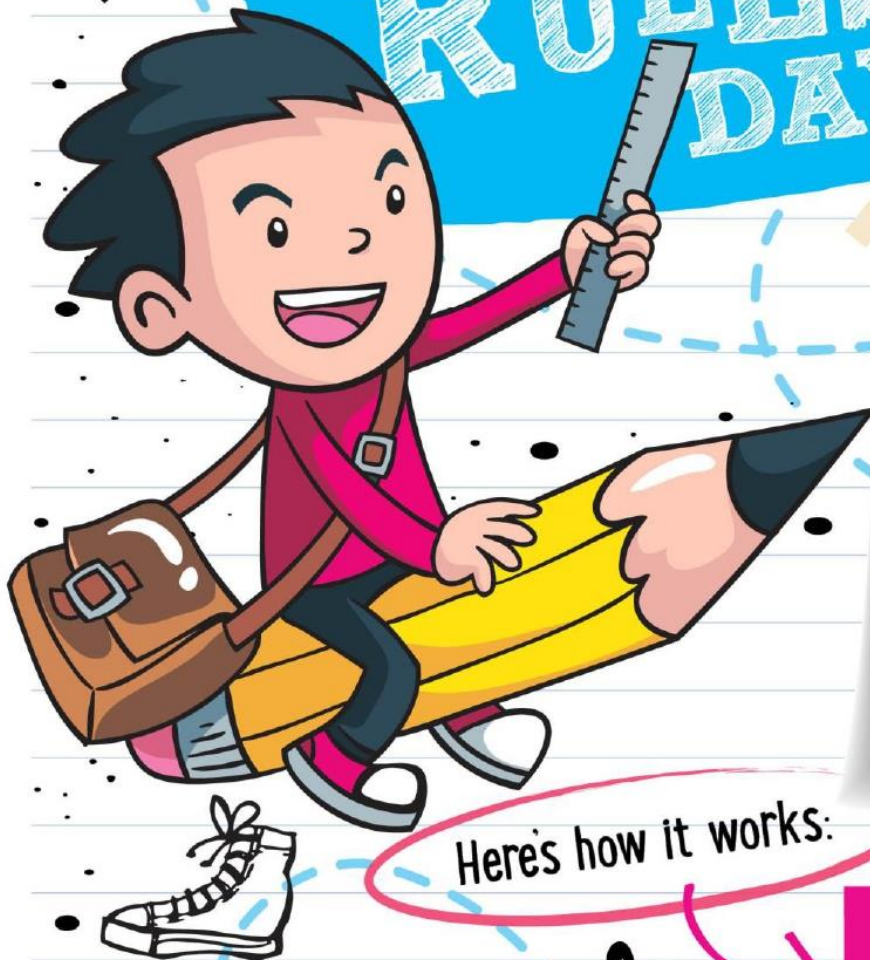


